WHAT IS Theraplay®?

Theraplay® was developed in the late 1960's by Dr. Ann Jernberg, a clinical psychologist, to meet the mental health needs of young children in the Head Start program in Chicago, where it is still a model. Since that time, Theraplay has been used successfully to help:

- Foster/adoptive children form secure attachments
- Children who are trauma victims
- Shy, withdrawn children
- Overactive, controlling or aggressive children
- Children with autism/PDD
- Children who are physically or mentally challenged
- Children who live in group settings
- Head Start, pre-school students and others who receive services in group settings

Theraplay® is a short-term, therapist-guided dyadic psychotherapy that focuses on parent-child relationships. It:

- Enhances attachment, self-esteem and trust in others through joyful engagement
- Is based on the natural patterns of healthy interaction between parent and child
- Focuses on four essential qualities found in parent-child relationships: Structure, Nurture, Engagement and Challenge
- Creates an active and empathic connection between child and parents
- Results in a changed view of the self as worthy and lovable, and of relationships as positive

PROGRAM CONTENT

- History and basic assumptions of Theraplay
- Theraplay and current attachment and brain research
- The four dimensions of Theraplay: Structure, Nurture, Engagement and Challenge
- The use of the Marshack Interaction Method (MIM) for assessment and treatment planning
- How Theraplay sessions are planned to meet the individual child's needs
- Methods for involving parents
- Adapting Theraplay for different populations
- Group Theraplay
- Determining when Theraplay should be used

Lecture, practice activities and video case examples will be used.
